## NFL FUTURES



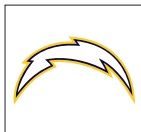
**New England Patriots (13-2):** Tom Brady and the "Patriot Way" always put New England's odds to win the Super Bowl in the top five. And this year, they are the overall favorite with the addition of deep threat Chad Ochocinco.



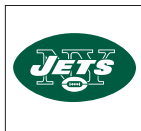
**Green Bay Packers (7/1):** The returning champs boast youth and talent at every position, making them Super Bowl contenders until the roster is blown up. Staying healthy is the only roadblock for a dominant Packers squad.



**Philadelphia Eagles (9/1):** According to Vince Young, the Eagles have formed a "Dream Team". With Michael Vick as QB, DeSean Jackson returning as the deep threat, and an improved defense that added Nnamdi Asomugha in the secondary, he could be right.



**San Diego Chargers (11/1):** Amidst all the free agency hoopla, you might be sleeping on a Chargers team that haven't made any big moves. But remember, QB Philip Rivers is one of the league's best and he'll have his favorite targets - Antonio Gates and Vincent Jackson - at 100 percent.



**New York Jets (12/1):** The Jets have swagger, and the talent to back it up, and should be back in the Super Bowl mix this season. The question for the Jets is: can their offense match their defense? The addition of red zone wideout Plaxico Burress will definitely help.



**Pittsburgh Steelers (12/1):** Dominant defense, smash-mouth game plans and a clutch QB: the Steelers always have the formula to be in the Super Bowl hunt. If star safety Troy Polamalu can stay healthy, expect Pittsburgh to brush off any signs of a Super Bowl hangover.

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## DIVISION WINNERS



**Philadelphia Eagles (1/1):** After adding Asomugha and Jason Babin to a defense that ranked 15th against the pass, the Eagles now have a squad that can dominate on both sides of the ball. It's Super Bowl or bust for the Eagles! The NFC East should be an easy accomplishment on that quest.



**Arizona Cardinals (13/4):** Although the NFC West was a crapshoot last year, the addition of Kevin Kolb to the Cardinals instantly makes them the favorite to take the division. All the Cards needed was a QB to toss TDs to Larry Fitzgerald. Kolb can do that and more.



**New England Patriots (2/3):** Winning the division is a layup for the Patriots. They've won the AFC East in 8 of the last 10 seasons. The New York Jets have the talent to knock off some of that championship swagger, but with Brady under center in New England, who would you bet on?



**Green Bay Packers (10/19):** With a Super Bowl under their belt, you'd expect Green Bay to be an easy bet to win the NFC North. However, they didn't take the division last year - that went to Chicago - and that's because the team was riddled with injuries. Only injuries should be able to slow them down.

**Arizona Cardinals (O/U 6.5):** Last year, the Cardinals mustered only five wins with their lack of a passable quarterback talent. Things have changed with Kevin Kolb dropping back. If he's somewhat serviceable in his starting role, he and WR Larry Fitzgerald could make magic on Sundays.



**Philadelphia Eagles (O/U 10.5):** Michael Vick, DeSean Jackson and Nnamdi Asomugha equal the second best Total in the NFL at 10.5. The question is - will it all come together? The OVER/UNDER hangs on Vick and Jackson's health.



**Carolina Panthers (O/U 4.5):** Cam Newton made the Auburn Tigers into NCAA Champions in just one season in the system. If he can bring just a fraction of that magic to the blunderous Carolina Panthers, they could shock bettors and oddsmakers.



**Dallas Cowboys (O/U 9):** Remember the Cowboys, "America's Team"? They've been flying under the radar all offseason. Tony Romo is back and star receiver Dez Bryant is ready to explode in his second season. The Cowboys could surprise the NFC East.



**Minnesota Vikings (O/U 7):** Is Donovan McNabb finished, or was that awful season in Washington a product of Mike Shanahan's system? That'll be the question bettors have to ask. The Viking's defense is intact, and Adrian Peterson is still trucking opponents. Minnesota needs throwback McNabb to go OVER.

## MVP



**(GB) QB Aaron Rodgers (11/2):** Last time we checked, Rodgers was holding a championship belt while being showered with Super Bowl confetti. That alone gives him the pedigree to be the favorite for MVP. Concussions are the only issue that will keep him out of the running.



**(NE) QB Tom Brady (13/2):** The reigning MVP is back with a new target at wideout, a new haircut and an insane desire to grab his fourth Super Bowl ring. The last time Brady was a deep threat, he embarrassed NFL defenses by scoring 50 touchdowns with just eight INTs.



**(IND) QB Peyton Manning (15-2):** Don't sweat the neck surgery! As long as Manning ends up under center for the Colts, he'll be one of the favorites for NFL MVP. The man is QB and offensive coordinator combined, and looking for his sixth straight season where he tops 4,000 yards.



**(PHI) QB Michael Vick (17/2):** You can't gameplan for Vick, so expect him to give defense headaches every week. The only thing that can slow him down is his reckless running ability. Scrambling QBs tend to take tough hits from defenders.



**(NO) QB Drew Brees (10/1):** Brees had what many consider an off-year when compared to previous seasons in New Orleans. But keep in mind, he still topped 4,500 yards and had 30-plus touchdowns. Imagine if he comes out sharp again this year; it'll be a Mardi Gras for bettors.
